

On 1 August, 2022, the first stage of the collective agreement amounting to 3.0 percent will be coming into force. In these challenging times this will give employees in private banking some breathing room.

In view of persistently high inflation rates, we can unfortunately not and do not want to refer to this as a salary increase. In combination with the second stage and the single payments, however, the overall package will noticeably offer some relief.

We have only been capable of achieving this result because we fought for a deal with sincere commitment and persistence. After nine long months of tough and intense negotiations accompanied by numerous strikes and connected activities we finally at least managed to push through this package

Thus the result of the negotiations will now be implemented:

- Pay rise in two steps: 3.0 percent as from 1 August, 2022, a further 2.0 percent in August 2023
- Single payments of 500.00 euros (already in April 2022) and a further payment of 500.00 euros on 1 January 2023, 100.00 euros for trainees on each of these dates
- Term until 31 May, 2024

Where do we go from here?

Presently no talks are in progress regarding the outstanding issues and building blocks such as mobile working, junior staff schemes and discharge. Should this change, we will naturally keep you up to speed.
